Coopermook to Herons Creek

This project is jointly funded by the New South Wales and Australian governments

Nominations invited for Coopermook to Herons Creek community interest group

The NSW Roads and Traffic Authority (RTA) is forming an alliance team of Thiess and Parsons Brinckerhoff Australia Pty Ltd to design and construct approximately 33 km dual carriageway upgrade of the Pacific Highway from Coopermook to Herons Creek. The project includes 18 new bridges and bypasses of the villages of Moorland, Johns River and Kew.

Construction is due to commence in August 2007 and is scheduled to be completed in December 2009.

A Coopermook to Herons Creek community interest group is being established to facilitate community input into the project during the detailed design and construction phases. This is also consistent with the projects Conditions of Approval which requires the establishment of a community liaison group.

Nominations for membership of the interest group are being sought from local residents, community organisations, business representatives and other interested parties.
