## Site establishment work

The NSW Roads and Traffic Authority (RTA) is forming an alliance team with Thies and Parsons Brinckerhoff Australia Pty Ltd to design and construct the 33 km dual carriageway upgrade of the Pacific Highway from Cooperook to Herons Creek. The project includes about 20 new bridges and bypasses of the villages of Moorland, Johns River and Kew.

The project incorporates the Cooperook to Moorland and Moorland to Herons Creek Pacific Highway projects.

Construction is due to commence in late August 2007 and is scheduled to be completed by December 2009.

In preparation for the start of construction, several site offices and batch plants will be established along the length of the project. Construction of the project will be managed in three zones. There will be a site office and a concrete batch plant in each zone. Most sites were identified and assessed in the environmental impact statements in 2000 and 2005. All sites were subject to an additional environmental and social assessment in mid 2007 to ensure that the operational impacts of the sites can be managed.

In your area, the project office and display centre will be established in Wharf Road and a concrete batch plant will be established at the RTA's existing stockpile site on the eastern side of the Pacific Highway near Stoney Creek. This work will commence in early August. After the project has been completed, the project office, display centre and batch plant will be demobilised and the sites rehabilitated.

The types of site establishment activities you will see in the next three months include:

- Installing jersey kerbs and construction accesses.
- Clearing and levelling of some land.
- Removing some vegetation.
- Placing hardstand areas and footpaths.
- Replacing boundary fencing.
- Relocating services and utilities.
- Assembling sheds, demountable buildings and other structures.
