Dear resident and business operator

Start of clearing south of Ocean Drive

The Roads and Traffic Authority of NSW (RTA) has formed an alliance team with Thiess Pty Ltd and Parsons Brinckerhoff Australia Pty Ltd to design and construct the 33 km dual carriageway upgrade of the Pacific Highway from Coopernook to Herons Creek. The project includes new bridges and bypasses of the villages of Moorland, Johns River and Kew.

The Pacific Highway bypass of Kew will be north and south of Ocean Drive about 200 metres to the east of the existing highway.

To construct this bypass and interchange, we will be clearing vegetation, undertaking earthworks and fencing the project boundary south of Ocean Drive to the Pacific Highway opposite Sunnyvale Road, from next week until 21 December, 2007, weather permitting. Work will continue in this area in January 2008.

You will hear noise from excavators, other heavy equipment, mulchers and reversing beepers.

The alliance apologises for any inconvenience this work may cause and will undertake every practical measure to minimise the impact on the residents and the environment.

Road safety

Motorists, pedestrians and cyclists are advised to observe all project signage and traffic control directions during construction. This will include temporary speed limit reductions adjacent to road work activities.

Construction hours

Construction work hours will be Monday to Friday from 7am to 6pm and Saturday from 8am to 1pm. Nearby residents will be advised of any construction work to occur outside normal working hours.
